

Bones of the Upper Limb

A. Scapula

1. Superior border
2. Medial border
3. Lateral border
4. Superior angle
5. Inferior angle
6. Acromial angle
7. Acromion
8. Coracoid process
9. Glenoid cavity
10. Supraglenoid and infraglenoid tubercle
11. Supraspinous fossa
12. Spine of scapula (Spinous process)
13. Infraspinous fossa
14. Subscapular fossa
15. Suprascapular notch
16. Greater scapular notch

B. Clavicle

1. Acromial end
2. Shaft of clavicle
3. Sternal end of clavicle

C. Humerus

I) Upper (proximal) end:

1. Head of humerus
2. Anatomical neck
3. Surgical neck
4. Greater tubercle
5. Lesser tubercle
6. Intertubercular (Bicipital) groove (lateral, medial lips and a floor)

II) Shaft of humerus

7. Deltoid tuberosity
8. Groove for radial nerve (spiral groove)

III) *Lower (distal) end:*

9. *Capitulum*
10. *Trochlea*
11. *Coronoid fossa*
12. *Radial fossa*
13. *Medial epicondyle*
14. *Lateral epicondyle*
15. *Medial supracondylar ridge*
16. *Lateral supracondylar ridge*
17. *Olecranon fossa*
